MULTILINGUAL PROGRAMS

Transitional Bilingual Program (PreK – 5)



Klein ISD offers

a bilingual program which serves Spanish-speaking students who have been identified as English Language Learners (ELLs).

Our bilingual program provides instruction in Spanish and English in the areas of literacy and academic content. Non-academic subjects such as art, music and physical education are taught in English only.

In our bilingual program, the role of the first language is to facilitate access to the curriculum while students learn English. As students move from grade to grade, time of instruction given in English increases, reaching a total immersion in the language.

English as a Second Language (ESL) (PreK – 12)

ESL is an intensive program of teaching English to develop proficiency in language skills: listening, speaking, reading and writing.

Student eligibility for the program is determined through the administration of a test of oral language proficiency, and parental permission to participate in the program is required. All instruction is in English and uses the grade-level Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) and the English Language Proficiency Standards (ELPS).



In Klein ISD it is our expectation that all students, including students enrolled in the bilingual or English as a Second Language (ESL) program, obtain higher achievement on state standards. The district curriculum is based on the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS).

The teachers of our bilingual and English as a Second Language (ESL) programs are



trained in how to plan and provide an excellent education for students whose first language is not English.

The curriculum and instruction of bilingual and English as a Second Language (ESL) programs are based on appropriate materials and strategies to accelerate the development of comprehension and communication in English.
